This NEBOSH (National Examination Board in Occupational Health & Safety) National Construction Certificate is aimed at Supervisors, Managers and CDM Co-ordinators within the construction industry that are required to ensure that activities under their control are undertaken safely. This is equivalent to the Level NQF / QCF certificate and is recognised by relevant professional membership bodies such as IOSH and CIWEM.

It is likely to prove useful for those concerned with the management of buildings who may need to ensure that contractors are working safely. The qualification is also appropriate for supervisors and managers working in other industries such as utilities, and even broadcasting, where temporary workplaces are a feature of their activities.
